- 1. Tuition is based on _____ hours of MTSU undergraduate/graduate credit hours. Students who participate on an education abroad program, when the course/courses in the program is/are the only course/courses for which the student is registered during that term, shall not be required to pay out-of-state tuition.
- 2. Subtotal represents fees paid to MTSU, billed on student RaiderNet account.
- 3. Student Program Fee (SPF) is the amount paid to the Faculty Leader's clearing account. It includes:
- 4. All students participating on MTSU Education Abroad programs pay a \$50 administration fee. All students participating on MTSU Faculty-Led programs pay the \$32 iNext fee for mandatory insurance. These fees are paid directly to the OEA as part of the Pathway Packet.
- 5. Miscellaneous Expenses are estimated by the Faculty Leader. These expenses includes:
- 6. Some visas may require students to travel in person to the nearest embassy/consulate, based on student's state of residence. Students are ultimately responsible to determine if a visa is necessary for their participation. Some countries also require entry and exit fees.

Please note that expenses are ESTIMATES, and are based on the costs for the 2015-16 academic year. Costs vary depending on the exchange rate, the inflation rate, individual spending habits, and amount of extra travel.
