



#### **Scholarship Application Deadlines**

Winter term 2014-15.......Wednesday, September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2014 Spring semester 2015......Thursday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2014 Late applications are not considered.

#### Eligibility Requirements: Students must meet ALL criteria for application to be considered.

- 1. Minimum OVERALL GPA requirement of 2.800 for undergraduates; 3.300 for graduates (GPA requirements are FIRM)
- 2. Must be enrolled at MTSU in the academic semester *prior* to the education abroad program
- 3. Must be enrolled at MTSU at the time of applying for the scholarship, meaning the deadline listed above
- 4. Must have completed a full-time term (12 credit hours for undergrad; 9 credit hours for grad; GA/GTA's should contact the Office of EA for credit hour requirement) at MTSU *before applying* for a scholarship
- 5. Must select a program that will end before graduation
- 6. Must receive academic credit (a minimum of one hour) for program
- 7. Must be an MTSU degree-seeking student
- 8. May apply only once if participating on academic year program (prior to the start of the first semester abroad)
- 9. Must submit a COMPLETE application (Cover Sheet, Application, & Essay)
- 10. Must follow essay requirements and receive sufficient points in order to receive a scholarship award
- 11. Must complete an MTSU Education Abroad Program Evaluation upon return

#### **Application & Essay Instructions**

- 1. All information in all sections of the application MUST be typed (with the exception of the required student's original signature and date on the Cover Sheet).
- 2. The essay must be:
  - Typed
  - At least one page, but may not exceed two pages (print single sided only)
  - Double-spaced in Times New Roman size 12 font with 1 inch margins
  - The student's name should NOT be on the essay, but the student's M# should be typed at the top of each page of the essay.
  - It will be assumed that ALL applicants a) strongly wish to study abroad b) will greatly benefit from their experience and c) need financial support. Your score will be negatively affected by repeating or restating these concepts.
  - Student's essays are graded by MTSU Faculty members and receive a score between 1-5. If a student's average essay score is a ZERO, s/he will not qualify for an award.
  - Choose ONE of the following topics and type Topic A or Topic B at the top of the essay.
    - **Topic A:** Please describe what would be your ideal education abroad experience AND focus specifically on how it would benefit you in your future vocation or chosen field.
    - **Topic B:** Tell us about how you might like to make a positive impact in the world through your education abroad experience. Your answer should relate to your intended area of study.
- 3. Students must submit a COMPLETE application to the Office of Education Abroad, Peck Hall, Room 207 by 4:30 p.m. on the published deadlines. Late or incomplete applications are NOT accepted or considered.
