

I've participated in an advising session. What do I do next?

It depends on your specific situation and what stage of the application process you are in currently.

In order to move forward to Step 4, you must choose a program. Hopefully after the advising session, you feel prepared to either choose a program or understand the research needed to make the decision. If not, you will want to come back in for another advising session.

During an advising session we will make some suggestions and provide you with some tasks to complete afterward. Depending on a number of factors, we might recommend that you request online pre-approval, apply for an actual program, meet with your Academic Advisor(s) to complete the Course Approval Form, meet with the study abroad representative in the Financial Aid Office, begin researching scholarships, create a calendar of deadlines, participate in a webinar, call your program provider, meet with a faculty leader, talk to past participants, etc.
