

## What is the Preliminary Application for MTSU Exchange Programs?

Students must be officially nominated to the exchange partner universities by the MTSU Office of Education Abroad, the Exchange Faculty Advisor, and the Vice Provost for International Affairs. This application is used to determine which students will be nominated.

- 1. Short essay: One to two pages (typed) answering the following questions.
  - a. What are your reasons for studying abroad? What do you hope to achieve?
  - b. Exchange programs work best for motivated, independent students. You may be the only MTSU student participating on this particular exchange program in the term you are abroad. In addition, you may have to apply for a student visa without a great deal of guidance. When you email your host university with questions, it may take a few weeks to receive a response. Keeping all of this in mind, what qualities do you possess which make you a good candidate for an exchange program?
- 2. EA Course Approval Form signed by student and Academic Advisor(s).

#### PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY AND SIGN:

MTSU Exchange programs are offered through bilateral exchange agreements between MTSU and our partner universities abroad. This means we are only able to send as many students abroad as we will receive from that university. Therefore, some exchange programs may only be available during certain semesters and/or only a few students may be chosen to participate. Participation in a particular exchange program is not guaranteed and a back-up education abroad program is recommended for all exchange applicants.

Participants will be enrolled as regular students at the partner university but will pay MTSU fees for tuition (and sometimes room and meals depending on the exchange agreement). Exchange programs are ideal for students who want to challenge themselves by fully integrating into the day-to-day academic and personal life of the host country.

Because these programs do not offer the level of support other education abroad programs do, participants should be highly motivated, interested in planning their own semester activities and excursions, and feel comfortable seeking out details without a great deal of guidance and reminders. Students who are not comfortable with these responsibilities should apply for a different type of education abroad program which offers more support.
