MEDIA SCHOLARSHIP - INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Students must meet all criteria for consideration.

LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

SPRING BREAK DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 7, 2020

SUMMER DEADLINE: MARCH 20, 2020

- 1. Must be an MTSU degree-seeking student at the time of application and during the education abroad program
- 2. Must select an MTSU Signature Education Abroad Program that will end before graduation.
- 3. Must be enrolled at MTSU at the time of application
- 4. Must receive academic credit (minimum of one hour) for the program during the term abroad
- 5. Must submit a complete application
- 6. Must have Office of Education Abroad preapproval confirmation for the program and have been accepted into the program by the Faculty Director(s) by the scholarship deadline

AWARD STRUCTURE

- Ten (10) Media Scholarships at \$500 each will be awarded
- Only one Media Scholarship will be awarded in a single MTSU Signature Program
- Spring break scholarships are released after the scholarship deadline and prior to the program start date
- Summer scholarships are released at the beginning of the summer term per current financial aid regulations
- The awardee grants the MTSU Office of Education Abroad free use of the final project in whole or in part
- Students have 2 months to submit the completed project to the Office of Education Abroad after the final study abroad program date, otherwise the scholarship award will be reversed in the student's Pipeline account.

PROJECT STRUCTURE

The project requirements are intended to encourage creativity of expression. Your project must highlight your experience on an MTSU Signature Education Abroad Program. The medium of the project is your choice: photography (image), video, print, web, or other. Examples include:

- Blogging before, during (daily), and after the program following a theme and incorporating quality photos
- Vlogs via YouTube or other online medium, highlighting your study abroad country and course activities
- Photo collection with captions
- Video about your program
- Podcasts to be shared with social media
- Songwriting about an aspect of/influenced by your study abroad program
- Artistic creations in print or other medium to showcase your program and experience

Unique and creative ideas are encouraged!

SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

- An award letter will be sent via MTSU email to confirm acceptance after the scholarship deadline.
- Students receiving a Media Scholarship will be required to sign an acceptance letter stating their understanding of the requirements, expectations, and scholarship/award policies
